How did Jesus make His teaching STICKY like a **bur** that sticks to your clothes as you walk in the outdoors? The content of His teaching usually catches our attention, but what about the context? If you want to emulate the teaching techniques of Jesus you have to pay attention to your surroundings. He didn't teach in a vacuum. The one-two punch of His teaching style was the way he combined <u>Setting & Timing with Intentional Content</u> to tie the <u>K</u>not of learning which persuaded people to say <u>Y</u>es to His Good News of the Kingdom of God. A bur is a seed that will grow in good soil. STICKY bur method will *stick* with your group because it models the experiential in nature Jesus Christ's teaching style.
